The paddling pool has been used for the past 30 years by many young families who were able to use the free-to-attend pool in the school holidays. As we experience the effects of global warming and the longer, hotter summers the pool has become an important feature for families without their own gardens to cool off and enjoy the fresh air and outdoor space.





#### Community Survey for Alexandra Recreation Ground

Sadly, due to an increase in repairs and maintenance needs, the pool was only open for 5 days in Summer 2019 and a few weeks in 2018. Clearly, this is not sustainable, so we wish to propose a new project to idverde and London Borough of Bromley for a replacement for this recreational feature

We are now seeking your views on how you might like to see this area developed so that we can support any redevelopment project knowing we have the opinions of our members, the residents and park users






# 1. How often do you currently use Alexandra Recreation Ground?


# 2. If you visit Alexandra Recreation Ground what is/are your reason/s? (Tick all that apply)


# 3 How long on average do you tend to spend at the park when you visit?








# 4. How would you rate the park as a place to visit?






# 5. Options for the paddling pool area





we need to have a water play feature as there is nothing for a few miles and we are in an impoverished part of the borough- with high volum of young families and social housing We would love a sandpit area like the playground opposite
Horniman has where paddling is now; less high maintenance
than water with some taller climbing structures over than
Crystal Palace. Maybe water like Coram's Fields but might
overcomplicate.

This is a very badly-designed survey.

This is an incredibly poorly designed questionnaire. Not only is it riddled with errors, but more importantly it is difficult to work out how it's supposed to be completed. There will be a lot of false responses because it's so confusing.

A water play area is desperately needed particularly as the weather heats up. A stepping water padded area would be ideal so children can play, stay hygienic and not waste water would be ideal. Something like Wells park.

We have very few water play areas in the area. The one is beckenham is always so popular and busy as the Alex Rec one is rarely usable. I would strongly advise keeping a water play area there but enhancing it with maybe a small cafe / picnic areas.

Preference: Community garden to be sensory based and accessibility focussed. A small cafe/deal with a coffee/food can anywhere would be a massive boon for the park
